  - Historical project of the foundation
  - Ongoing and successful project
  - Good state of infrastructures



# UEFA Foundation – Project Jordan

- Where we stand:
  - Achievements:
    - Za'atari and Azraq refugee camps
      - Training of male and female instructors
      - Training and setting up of a coordination unit
      - Construction of infrastructures
      - Organization of daily sports and recreational activities (football, zumba, judo, e-sport, reading...)
      - Organization of competitions and events within the refugee camps
      - Ownership of the project









# UEFA Foundation - Project Jordan

- Where we stand:
  - Achievements:
    - Outside refugee camps
      - Project implemented through schools
      - Several training seminars for PE teachers (including Karak, Aqaba, Amman and Mafrag)



# UEFA Foundation – Project Jordan

- Where we stand:

- Achievements:

- Some numbers

- 434 coaches trained (124 female coaches)
      - 37'000 children have been participated since the beginning
      - Coordination unit: 7 (28 coaches) in Za'atari and 2 (16 coaches) in Azraq
      - Beneficiaries in Azraq: 2'300 children in Azraq (boys 1'300 and girls 1'000)
      - Beneficiaries in Za'atari: 6'200 children (boys 3'500 and girls 2'700)

# UEFA Foundation – Project Jordan

- Achievements:

- Impact

- Change of mentality
      - Support of parents and community
      - Improvement of the children behaviours
      - Increase of self confidence within the female population
      - Diminution of violence / vandalism
      - Decrease of early pregnancy / early marriage



# UEFA Foundation – Project Jordan

- Where we stand:
  - Situation of the camps
    - Stabilisation of the population
    - Increase of the number of birth rates
    - No intention to close the camps
  - In General
    - Integration within the communities in Jordan
    - Diminution of fundings



# UEFA Foundation – Project Jordan



- Where we stand:
  - Za'atari refugee camp
    - Number of refugees has been stable since 2015
    - Around 80,000 people
    - 50% female
    - 54% under 18 years old

# UEFA Foundation – Project Jordan

- Where we stand:
  - Azraq refugee camp
    - Number of refugees slightly going up since 2019
    - Around 50'000 people
    - 49% female
    - 59% under 18 years old

    - Community problems with a Syrian identity within the Jordanian competitions
